

RULES/LAWS OF THE LAKE

- * OPERATION OF A SPEEDBOAT IS BETWEEN THE HOURS 10 A.M. & 6:30 P.M. ALL OTHER TIMES: 10 MPH.**
- * NO PERSON SHALL EVER OPERATE ANY BOAT AT A RATE OF SPEED GREATER THAN WHAT IS REASONABLE AND PRUDENT.**
- * ALL MOTOR-POWERED CRAFT ARE TO OPERATE IN A COUNTER-CLOCKWISE DIRECTION.**
- * ALL MOTOR-POWERED CRAFT MUST HAVE THE REGISTRATION WITH THE BOAT AT ALL TIMES.**
- * NO MOTOR-POWERED CRAFT MAY TRAVEL INSIDE THE BUOYS PARALLEL TO SHORE.**
- * BOATS/JET SKIS PULLING A SKIER/TUBE MUST HAVE AN OBSERVER.**
- * NO PERSON SHALL BE BEHIND ANY CRAFT BEFORE 10 A.M. OR AFTER 6:30 P.M.**
- * ALL MOTOR-POWERED CRAFT MUST BE PROPERLY LIGHTED FOR NIGHT TIME.**
- * A POWER BOAT MUST NOT BE OPERATED WITHIN 200 FEET OF THE SHORELINE IN INDIANA & WITHIN 100 FEET OF THE NEAREST OBSTACLE (PIER OR SWIM RAFT) IN MIGHIGAN.**
- * BOAT CAPACITY IS THE NUMBER OF PERSONS OR WEIGHT.... WHICHEVER COMES FIRST.**
